Primarily the Beth Mary Home started its journey in the year of 2014 with only 10 helpless street children and later it has included another 12 children and it means now 22 children are living into this Home. Most of them are age about not more than 6 years and some of children not have their mother or either father or some cases they have lost their both father and mother. In the light of Aloskha RSD Center has taken this specialized initiative to ensure their rehabilitation including education, health and create employment opportunity in ebullient future. Currently all of children are studying in the Maria Child Care School that are operated and guided by the Aloskha RSD Center. The chief initiator of the Home, Mrs. Martha Halder who thinks that it would be possible to established them in the main stream of our society at large through this service. Presently 12 children have come from Chittagong Hill tract zone and 10 children are come from Barisal and Kotalipara and apart from the many of children are coming every day from different geographic part of the country to this home but it had not been possible to received them due to financial constrain and lack of other support. Merely as a private sector initiative it would have been not possible in meeting up to huge expense of study, dress, treatment, food and shelter etc that we have to endure since 2014 -2017. In respect of we are earnestly requesting to extend helping hands for kind hearted man who is like to be support us at regional, national or international levels.
